The major mysteries persisting in our enlightened times can be divided in three categories:

- physics
- spirituality
- enigmas.

Physics has made truly admirable progress. The microcosm of the atom and the sub-atomic particles has been studied as much as the macrocosm of the universe. Physics in the microcosm has reached its limits with the uncertainty principle of Heisenberg. To put it simply; the moment you look at something you change it because you add energy to it. Also, matter can be a particle or a wave and a wave is energy that does not exist in a dimension. This expresses very clearly the limits of matter physics. Once the threshold to energy has been crossed the science of physics cannot follow.

The universe is the macrocosm we live in. Its origin in the so-called Big Bang has been

established going back to the so-called Plank time when the entire universe was so small that it can be expressed in the formula 10^{-43} . That's smaller than a hydrogen atom. It is assumed that the matter of the entire universe before exploded. - 4 dimensions define Matter: length, width, height and time. Before Plank time there were no dimensions other than in mathematical models. Therefore, what exploded in the Big Bang was not the entire matter of the previous universe; the energies of this previous universe corresponding to this matter exploded. For this reason science, which limits itself to the study of matter, cannot know what happened before.

In Western societies spirituality is the domain of organized mainstream religion. Cults, spiritualists, mediums etc. are viewed with suspicion and many times rightfully so. There is no clear concept of spirituality and people mostly are not aware that everyone is "spiritual". Without spirit there is no life. As soon as the spirit withdraws from a life form it is dead.

Spiritual energy or the energy of the quantum vacuum as science calls it is the energy behind matter. Thinking and feeling is done by these energies, which decide everything a person does. Spiritual energies are psychic energies but the word psychic has gotten a different meaning. A "psychic" is thought to be a person with special abilities. These will be explained in the chapter "Psychic Phenomena".

Spiritual energies can be programmed. This makes them immensely important because whoever knows how to program these energies decides what will happen and, thereby,

can influence future events. Several chapters deal with this aspect of spiritual energies known from religion. But there is another one aspect largely ignored by science and the general public. The realm of the quantum vacuum, the realm of the spiritual energies, is accessible to the ones who know how to do it. The ones, who do can use this realm for instant computing, communications between star systems, space travel and a lot more.
